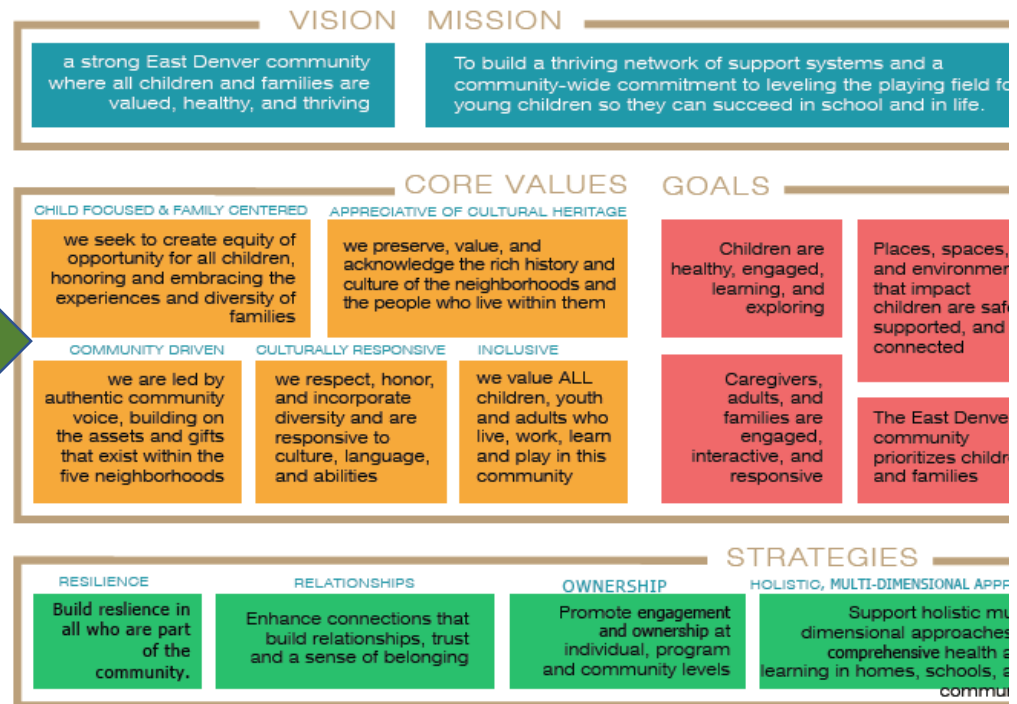

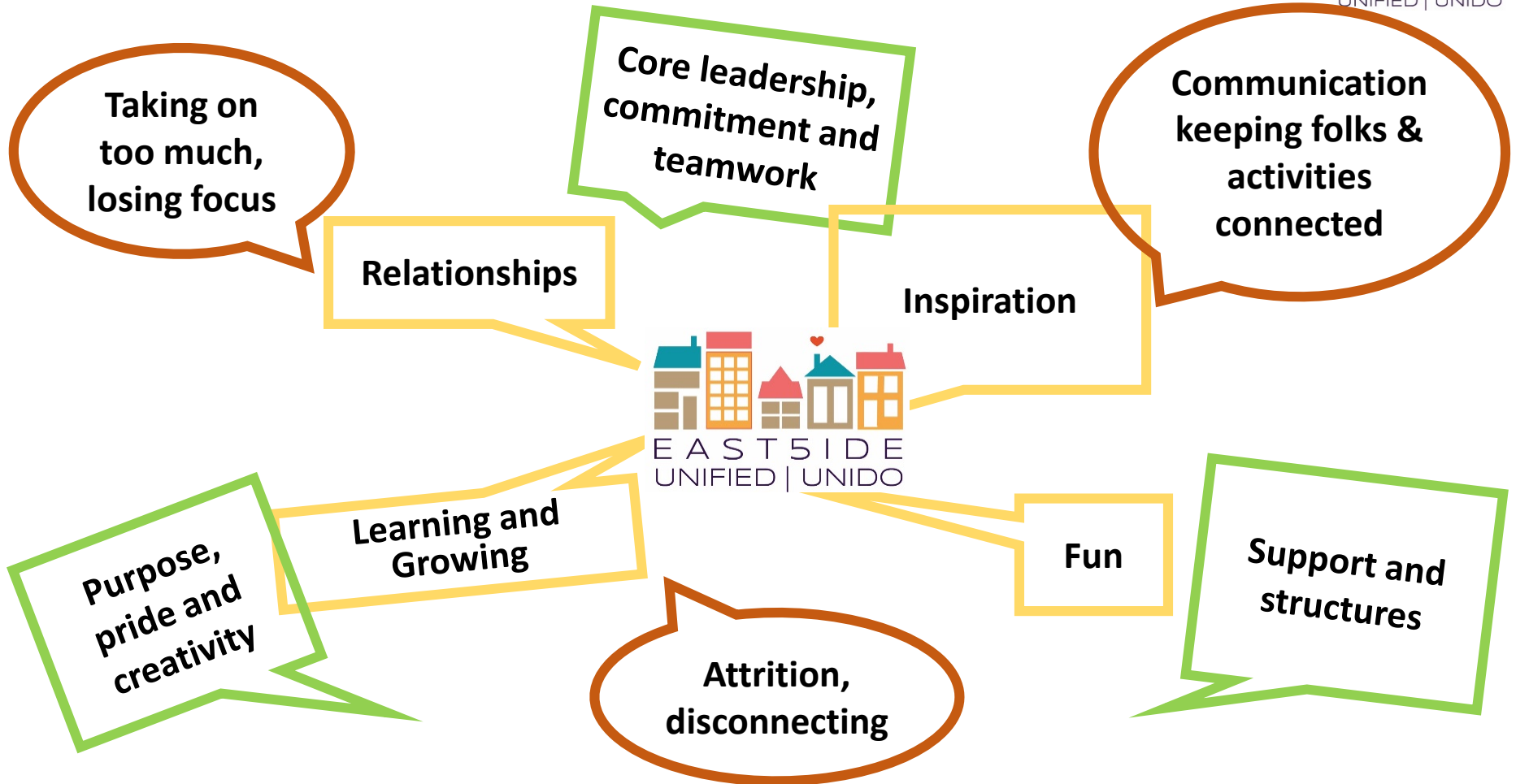


# Sample of East5Side Unified/Unido Progress

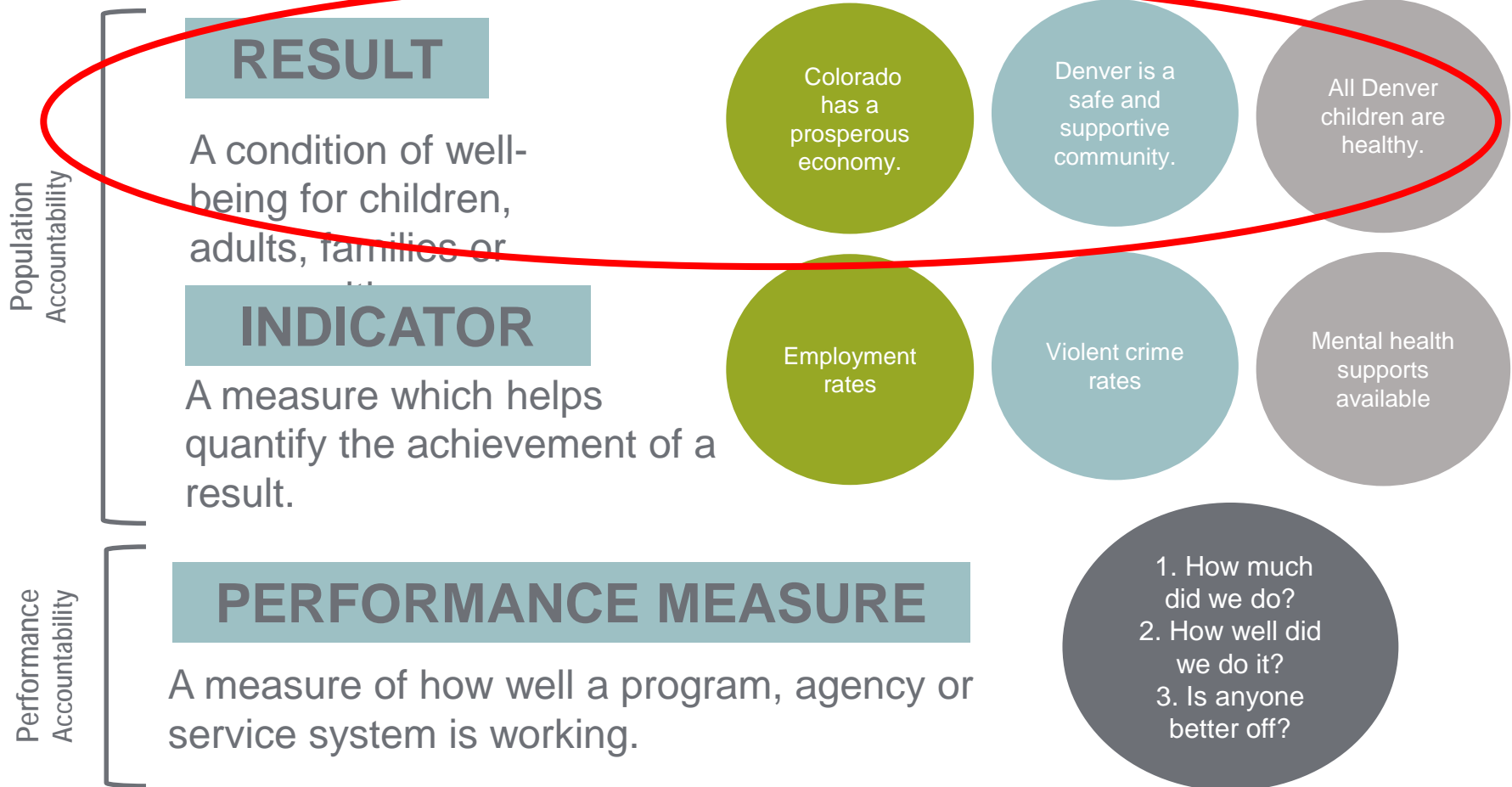

Promote engagement and ownership at individual, program and community levels

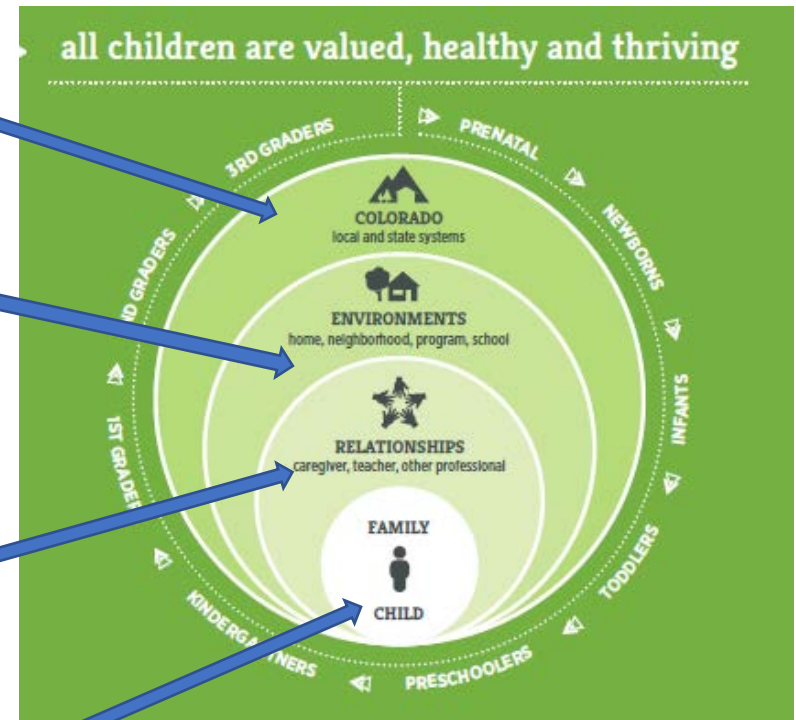

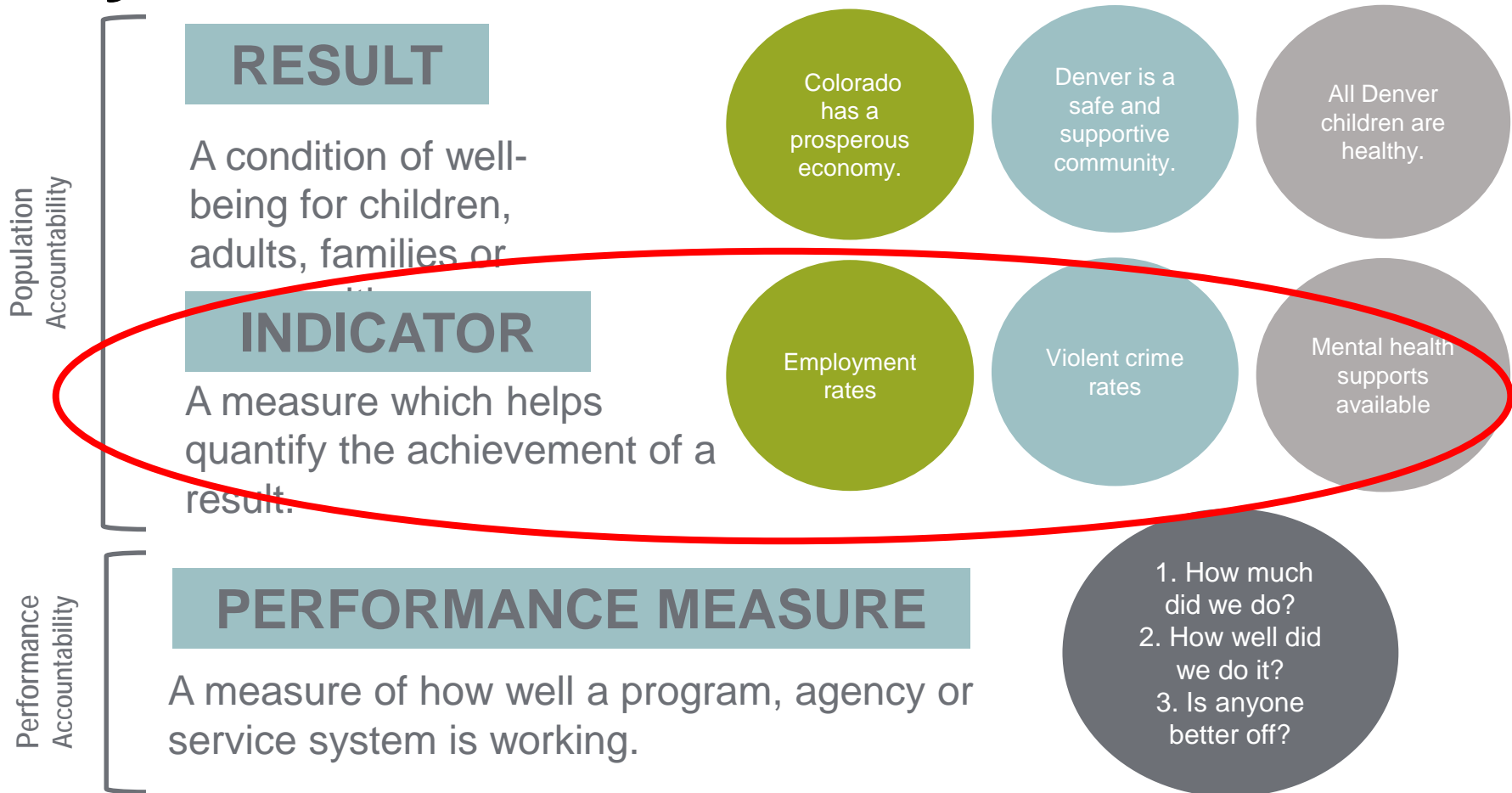

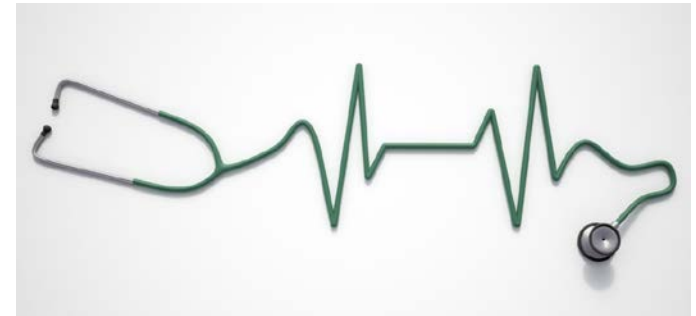

# Indicators as Vital Signs

- Picture indicators as “vital signs” for communities.
- Are things on track overall?  
What will tell us if things are off?
- If one vital sign is off, generally it’s indicative the bigger picture.



# Identify Indicators (help quantify result)



- Small group per Result:
  - Which most resonate?
  - What would you add?
- Hone in on top 3-5 total:
  - Does it communicate well?
  - Is the data available?
  - Does it directly connect to the result, EU vision? Is it a vital sign?
- NOTE: those without existing data source will help build a data agenda
- NOTE: capture the story/context on a sticky note
