# CRADLE TO GRAVE DATA COLLECTION

## Health Surveys & Evaluation Branch

- Collects &/or manages data
  - Pregnancy Risk Assessment Monitoring System (PRAMS)
  - Health eMoms
  - CO Child Health Survey (CHS)
  - Youth Risk Behavior Surveillance System (YRBS)
  - Healthy Kids Colorado Survey (HCKS)
  - Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System Survey (BRFSS)
  - The Attitudes and Behavior Survey on Tobacco and Health (TABS)
- Executes data analysis plan to produce results

## Registries & Vital Statistics Branch

- Collects &/or manages data
  - Birth & death certificate
  - Violent death reporting system
  - Hospital discharge data
  - Physician-assisted death
- Manages data access and privacy protection

- Roughly 188 data indicators
- 20+ data sources
  - Both internal (CDPHE) and external
- Workgroup with diverse backgrounds created indicator dataset
- Health Equity Model
  - Update on Statewide Health Assessment

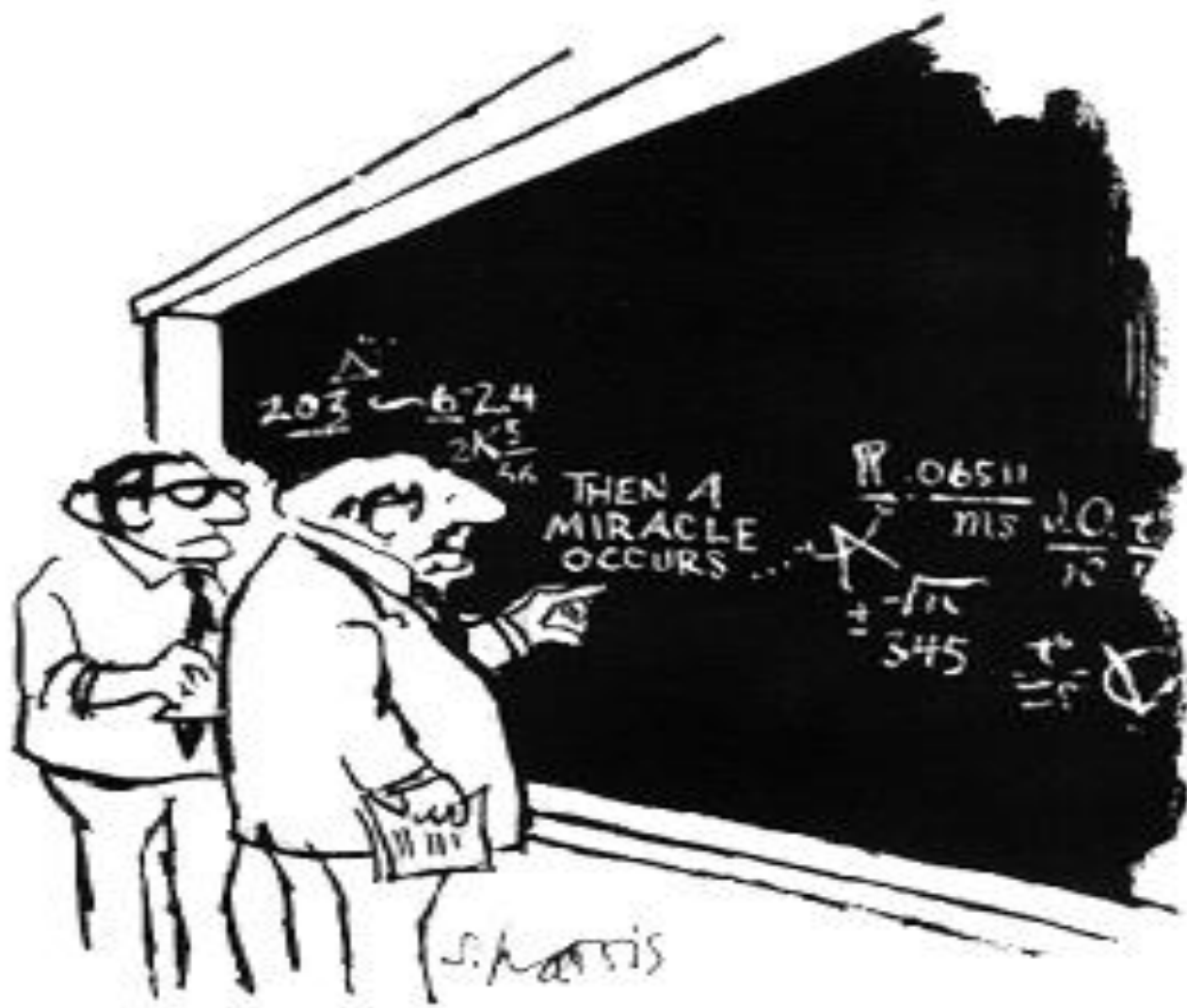
