Action Team Purpose	To expand EastSide Unified Unido understanding of and use of Asset Based Community Development (ABCD) Principles and approaches; to promote community connectivity through outreach and engagement; to support community leadership development
Vision of Success for June 2021: What do we want our impact to be?	We want residents of 80205 to feel connected, be involved, and show excitement for their community.
Action Team Deliverables by June 2021: What will we do to reach our vision?	<p>A. Cultivate and ensure strong relationships with our anchor institutions to ensure long-term sustainability and collaboration.</p> <p>B. Connect with and attend RNO or PTO meetings to listen and learn about things happening in the community, make connections, invite EastSide Unified and/or the Movement Maker participation, and liaison information collected back to the Movement Makers.</p> <p>C. Host regular community outreach projects or activities to connect with residents, including the Encouraging Hope Movement.</p>
Measures of Progress: How will we know we're successful in reaching our vision?	A. Meet with anchor institutions on a monthly basis to review joint projects and continue cultivating relationships. Institutions include St. Joe's, Center for African American Health, Denver Prep, DPS, Denver Museum of Nature Science, Denver Health, Metropolitan State University. Identifying SMART Indicators will be helpful, ie:

- a. Complete [2] [30-minute] status meetings with anchor institutions each month, and provide a ½ page status summary to the larger MM team with meeting successes, challenges, and updates.
- b. Each anchor organization will be invited to at least [2] [30-minute] status meetings during Year 3.
- c. By December 31, 2020, we will have completed at least [10] status meetings with [5] anchor institutions.
- d. By the end of Year 3, June 30, 2021, we will have completed at least [18] status meetings.

B. Identifying SMART Indicators will be helpful, ie:

- a. Identify at least [2] RNO / PTO groups to regularly engage, and then which Movement Maker team members will be liaison, by July 30, 2020.
- b. Attend at least 50% of scheduled RNO and PTO meetings of determined RNO / PTO, on a monthly basis.
- c. Meet with leadership of each determined RNO / PTO at least [2] times by December 31, 2020 to explore shared goals or possible collaboration opportunities to engage residents.
- d. By December 31, 2020, we will have recruited at least [9] new Movement Maker members.
- e. By the end of Year 3, June 30, 2021, we will have recruited at least [15] new Movement Maker members, and recruited [20] resident volunteers to help with outreach projects and activities.

C. Identifying SMART Indicators will be helpful, ie:

- a. Coordinate June's Encouraging Hope Movement and provide a list of opportunities to at least [150] residents regarding future community outreach events, volunteer opportunities, invitations to join the Movement Maker Action Team, by July 30, 2020.
- b. Coordinate [4] additional [Encouraging Home Movement] outreach projects or activities, by September 30, 2020.
- c. Recruit at least [4] new residents to volunteer with outreach projects or activities, for each event or a total of [16] new volunteers, by September 30, 2020.

By the end of Year 3, June 31, 2021, we will have [30] resident volunteers regularly supporting our events, [15] new Movement Maker members, and will have hosted at least [12] outreach events or activities.
