- *become focused with clear work plans and goals
- *formalize roles and responsibilities
- *refresh action team structures, purpose and connection
- *decide what "accountability" means and looks like
- *hire an experienced community organizer
- *ensure a complimentary role that provides coordination, communication, logistics, and work plan management functions
- *continue to build and deepen trust
- *continue feedback and learning cycles
